Host Species:	Goat
Size and Physical State:	1.0 ml in Freeze-dried powder
Antibody Concentration:	1 mg / ml
Source:	Polyclonal antibody purified by carboxymethyl-lysine modified BSA-Sepharose™ affinity column and labeled with FITC.
Preservation:	75 mM PBS, 75 mM NaCl, 0.5 mM EDTA, 0.02% NaN ₃ , pH 7.4.
Stabilizer:	5 mg / ml Bovine Serum Albumin.
Specificity:	Specifically binds to carboxymethyl-lysine modified protein. Molar F/P ratio is 2.7. The Investigator should determine working dilutions.
Use:	The antibody can be used to detect the existence of carboxymethyl-lysine modified protein with immunofluorescent approach.

Reconstitution and Storage: Freeze-dried product should be refrigerated until opened. After opening, restore to 1.0 ml with distilled water. If it is not completely clear after standing for 1-2 hours at room temperature, centrifuge the product. It is stable for several weeks at 4° C as an undiluted liquid. Do not use for more than one day after dilution. The products are light sensitive and should be kept in dark. To avoid repeated freezing and thawing after reconstitution, we suggest aliquots and storage at -20° C.

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
